





HOUSING PROGRAMS FOR CAL POLY POMONA FACULTY AND STAFF

Cal Poly Pomona is committed to recruiting high quality faculty and staff and is aware of the challenges encountered in relocating and finding affordable housing. Cal Poly Pomona Foundation currently has housing assistance available to assist you in your search for a new home.

Unlike traditional home ownership, a faculty/staff member buying a home in the faculty/staff housing program will purchase the home but lease the land from the Foundation, greatly reducing costs and enabling university professionals to own a new home near Cal Poly Pomona.



Fair Oaks Walk Community

This community built in 2008 is located 7 miles from campus and consists of 34 townhomes that have 1500-1700 sq. ft. of living space. Fair Oaks Walk is the first new off campus, homeownership program of Cal Poly Pomona Foundation, Inc., built specifically for the benefit of the faculty and staff at Cal Poly Pomona.

Kellogg Tract Homes

In 2004, Cal Poly Pomona Foundation began acquiring existing single-family homes in the community adjacent to the American Red Cross. The 17 homes have been extensively renovated and all offer walking-distance convenient to Cal Poly Pomona. These detached homes range from 1,100 – 1,700 sq. ft. of living space and have lots sized at approximately 6,000 square feet. All are single-level with 3 to 4 bedrooms, originally built in the mid 1950's.
